



CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR INTRAMURAL GRANT FUNDING

To The Medical City Network:

The Clinical and Translational Research Institute (CTRI) is glad to announce that we are now accepting applications for the 2022 Intramural Grants for Quality Improvement and Biomedical Research. CTRI is committed in providing financial support to top researchers in TMC Network with the aim of improving our hospital administrative and clinical processes by using rigorous research methods and innovative experimental techniques. As such, we are opening SIX slots for the grant this year, each will be receiving a stimulus fund for the implementation of their projects! The application and grant management guidelines are as follows:

- Only quality improvement, hospital operations, and biomedical research proposals will be qualified for application. Three (3) slots will be provided for quality improvement and hospital operations research, and another three slots (3) for biomedical research.
- The Principal Investigator of the research should be currently affiliated with any TMC Network. In the case of trainee's research, a qualified TMC consultant/ staff should serve as an adviser or co-investigator.
- A maximum of PhP 100,000.00 will be allocated to the successful applicants, depending on their approved line-item budget for the research. Only the justified line items will be considered for the fund usage.
- To submit an application, a capsule proposal should be prepared and submitted to the CTRI website by following these steps:
 - Go to www.themedicalcity.com/ctri
 - Click the "Grants and Applications" tab on the main menu
 - Click "Intramural Grants- Preliminary" on the submenu
 - Fill in the necessary boxes with the corresponding information (NB: for research category, please choose "General Category Study." Please take note that each entry box will only accept a maximum of 500 words)
 - Upload the necessary files in the corresponding items (NB: please take note of the allowed formats for uploading)
 - Enter an active email address for the corresponding author
 - Read and accept the confidentiality disclosure agreement, then click "Submit"
- Only complete capsule proposal submissions will proceed to the screening process by the CTRI Scientific Advisory Committee. The committee will screen the proposals based on their merit, relevance to TMC, proposed methods, feasibility, budget allocation, and research plan.
- Successful applicants in the preliminary screening will receive an official invitation for an oral presentation. The CTRI Scientific Advisory Committee will be the panel for the presentation. The final ranking of the committee will be the basis for choosing the top proposals to receive the grant.
- The official grantees will receive additional instructions from CTRI on how to avail the grant. A grant certificate will be awarded during the closing ceremony of the Research Week 2023 celebration.
